

Category 4: Stewardship

LAND AND TRAIL STEWARD

Description of Position

Stewards perform basic trail maintenance functions including trimming, simple boardwalk repair, removing debris, and sign replacement or installment. This position may also entail manually removing invasive plant species. Trail maintenance will be conducted using a variety of hand tools which require training on how to properly and safely use the tools. The Land and Trail Steward may work independently or assist staff with larger stewardship projects.

Qualifications

- Ability to walk various distances over uneven surfaces and boardwalks
- Ability to work in varied temperatures
- Ability to learn and use a variety of hand tools
- Ability to work with other volunteers as well as unsupervised
- Ability to communicate both orally and in writing to GRNA, Inc. staff and the general public
