WILDFLOWER BLOOM TIMES

The average bloom periods for some late summer wildflowers are highlighted below as recorded at GRNA and other areas in Antrim County. Bloom times may vary by a week or two depending on location and seasonal weather from year to year. Shifts in blooming over time can be used as indicators of climate change. The study of the seasonal timing of biological events is called phenology.
