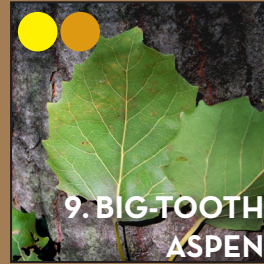

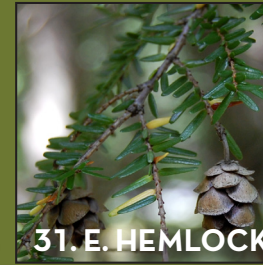

Yellow circle: Typical fall color is shown in the corner for each tree



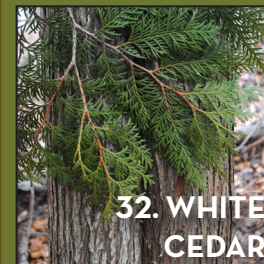
